**Special Presentations:**

Chief Operating Officer Ryan Ratcliff of Central Maine & Quebec Railway gave a presentation of the current status of the Central Maine & Quebec Railway focusing on capitol, operating practices, safety ratings/procedures/maintenance, and current investments.

**Town Manager's Report:**

\* stated approximately 70 foreclosure notices were mailed out on November 18<sup>th</sup>, noting that the homeowners have until January 2, 2016 before the properties become Town tax acquired.

\* proposed a discussion per Councilor Madore's request concerning the disbursement of the SMI TIF funds.

\* noted the Municipal Review Committee will be meeting on December 3<sup>rd</sup> in East Millinocket's Town Office to discuss the options of disposal of future Municipal Solid Waste (MRS).

\*informed that the current road status for paving has been put on hold until spring due to unforeseen breakdowns on Steel Stone's behalf, explained the current shimming of targeted areas is not at the final state.

\*noted the Color Me for Books Fundraiser date has been rescheduled for May 21, 2016.

\*stated a new safety policy has been implemented at the Transfer Site by the Director of the Town's Transfer Site prompted by another Town's tragic accident that occurred recently, explained the overhead door will be closed for vehicle traffic when an employee is working in the location of the compact hopper on the main floor.

The Council had a brief discussion concerning the disbursement of the SMI TIF Funds for promoting Economic Development.





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PREMISE DIAGRAM


