GUIDELINES FOR BURN PERMITS

State law requires a burn permit be issued for all open fires. Permits may be obtained at the Millinocket Fire Department for areas within the town limits. Permits are not required for outdoor cooking fires as long as they meet approval of the Millinocket Fire Dept. Outdoor fireplaces still require safety measures be in place, such as always being attended, extinguishment capabilities, and adult supervision. Millinocket is located in weather zone 4 on the state fire danger map.

Millinocket Fire Department Open Burning Guidelines:

1. Permits will be issued after 1700 Hrs on Weekdays and all day on Weekends.
2. Permits will only be issued if the fire danger is a class 3 or less and the wind speed is less than 10 mph.
3. You must be at least 18 years old to obtain a permit.
4. You must follow the safety requirements shown on the permit or otherwise provided by the department.
5. All burns must be at least 20 feet from a structure.
6. Fires must be attended at all times.
7. Permits will only be issued to property owners or you must have written permission from the property owner.
8. Smoke from any outdoor fire must not bother your neighbors. If a complaint is received, you may be asked by Millinocket Fire or Police personnel to extinguish the fire and are mandated to comply.
