Foreclosures

Sixteen of the 70 foreclosure notices that were sent out have now been paid. Homeowners have until January 2, 2016, to pay their 2014 taxes or the homes will be automatically foreclosed.

Sewer Fees

The staff is in the process of trying to collect some sewer fees that should have been liened in 2014.

Lights at Veteran's Park

The street lights that shine on the monument at Veteran's Park have been disconnected because people coming in contact with the pole were getting a shock. Ralph has contacted Bangor Hydro to see if they can put in a ground wire and hook them up again. If this cannot be done, perhaps the Town can look into the possibility of hooking up the same type of light that has been attached to the new sign that was erected on Central Street by the bridge this summer.

Penobscot Indian Nation Lawsuit

The Town received an email from Matt Manahan, Chair of the Environmental & Land Use Practice Group, stating that the Court's decision on the PIN lawsuit is a victory for the State because it unequivocally rules that the PIN Reservation does not include any portion of the Penobscot River, only the islands themselves.

Memorial Day Flags

Walter Lougee of World of Flags, U.S.A., informed me that a statute was passed that makes it the obligation of the individual towns to finance the cost for the flags and flag holders that are put near the headstones at the cemetery. Historically, the cost has been picked up by the Town, American Legion, V.F.W., or a combination of the three. Due to a lack of finances, it does not appear that the V.F.W. or the American Legion will have the funds to donate this year. The Town normally purchases eight boxes at a total cost of \$1,175.04.

Subject: PIN v. Mills Court Order
Importance: High

Judge Singal has today issued his decision in the *PIN v. Mills* lawsuit. I am pleased to report that the decision is a victory for the State and for our coalition, because it unequivocally rules that the PIN reservation does NOT include any portion of the Penobscot River, only the islands themselves. This means that the PIN cannot regulate our coalition's discharges to the river, or other activities in and on the river. While Judge Singal ruled that the PIN has sustenance fishing rights in the river (thus potentially meaning that MDEP and EPA must ensure that the water quality is sufficient to support sustenance fishing), the PIN itself will not have jurisdiction over the river – or over the members of our coalition. We had already acknowledged that PIN has sustenance fishing rights from the islands and into the river, so the sustenance fishing portion of Judge Singal's ruling does not affect our prior position or change anything.

Although Judge Singal did not mention our coalition's arguments in his primary decision, he issued a separate order (also attached) to say that he incorporates his primary decision into his ruling that grants our summary judgment motion. Importantly, the basis for Judge Singal's ruling that the PIN Reservation does not include any portion of the Penobscot River was our "plain language" argument:

"In short, the Court concludes that the plain language of the Settlement Acts is not ambiguous. The Settlement Acts clearly define the Penobscot Indian Reservation to include the delineated islands of the Main Stem, but do not suggest that any of the waters of the Main Stem fall within the Penobscot Indian Reservation. That clear statutory language provides no opportunity to suggest that any of the waters of the Main Stem are also included within the boundaries of the Penobscot Indian Reservation."

See page 56. This was our point all along.

Although Judge Singal says (pages 50-51) that he is "not resolving the right to regulate water sampling or the right to regulate discharges by towns or non-tribal entities that currently discharge into the Penobscot River," he in fact does resolve that issue by ruling that the PIN Reservation does not include any portion of the river.

Thank you for your support during this long process. No doubt the PIN will appeal, but this is an important victory in upholding the terms of the Maine Indian Land Claims Settlement Act, and avoiding expensive and duplicative tribal regulation of our coalition members.

Legal TOWN MGR. MELLINOX ET ME

VETERANS GRAVES

With Veterans Day (November 11th) fast approaching, it may be appropriate to remind municipalities of their various legal duties respecting veterans' graves.

Maintenance and repair of monuments; mowing. In any ancient burying ground (private cemetery established before 1880) or any public burying ground in which any Revolutionary soldiers or sailors or wartime veterans of the U.S. Armed Forces are buried, the municipality in which the burying ground is located "shall keep in good condition and repair, all graves, headstones, monuments or markers designating the burial place" of these Revolutionary soldiers or sailors or wartime veterans and "shall keep the grass suitably cut and trimmed from May 1st to September 30th of each year" (13 M.R.S.A. § 1101). This requirement applies only to the graves of Revolutionary soldiers and sailors and wartime veterans. "War" is not defined in the statute but appears to include any generally recognized hostilities including the Korean, Vietnam and Gulf Wars. Military service in any capacity during wartime also appears to qualify.

Memorial Day flags. Each municipality, as directed by its municipal officers, "annually shall decorate on the day Memorial Day is observed the graves of veterans of the Armed Forces of the United States of America with an American flag and appropriate flag holders" (30-A M.R.S.A. § 2901(1)). This requirement applies to the graves of all veterans, both wartime and peacetime. Flying an American flag from a single flagpole is no longer an acceptable alternative. The statute formerly required "floral decorations" as well, but this too has been repealed.

Veterans Day bell ringing. Each municipality shall cause any public bell or

clarion within its possession or control to be rung at 11 a.m. on Veterans Day "unless it would cause the municipality to incur additional expense." (The Armistice that ended World War I took effect at 11 a.m. on November 11, 1918; until World War II, Veterans Day was called Armistice Day.) The municipal officer shall also request that any other bell or clarion within the municipality be rung voluntarily at that same time "and shall take such other steps as are necessary to properly coordinate public and volunteer events" (13 M.R.S.A. § 2901(4)).

Access to ancient burying grounds. The owner of any ancient burying ground shall provide the municipality access to perform its duties under 13 M.R.S.A. § 1101 and 30-A M.R.S.A. §

2901(1) or shall assume the duties, which case the municipality is exempted (13 M.R.S.A. § 1101-B). If the owner unreasonably denies access to the municipality, the owner can be held liable for any fines, court costs and attorney's fees incurred by the municipality in gaining access or for failing to perform duties under 13 M.R.S.A. § 1101.

Unorganized townships. If an ancient burying ground or veterans' graves are located in an unorganized township, the county in which that township is located has the duties prescribed in 13 M.R.S.A. § 1101 and 30-A M.R.S.A. § 2901.

Graves on Federal land. Veterans' graves located on land owned by the Federal Government as of January 1, 2000 are not subject to the require-

Municipal Calendar

BY NOVEMBER 1 — Any governmental subdivision holding tangible or intangible property presumed abandoned under 33 MRSA §1953 must make report to the Administrator of Abandoned Property of the State Treasury Department, pursuant to 33 MRSA §1958.

BY NOVEMBER 1 — Or 90 days after the date of commitment, whichever is later, the municipal assessors and assessors of primary assessing areas shall make return to the State Tax Assessor all information as to the assessment of property and collection of taxes. The forms of such return shall be supplied by the State Tax Assessor (36 MRSA §383)

NOTE: Failure to file this return in a timely manner could result in loss of tree growth reimbursement (36 MRSA §578)

BEFORE NOVEMBER 7 — Election Day. Registrars of voters shall accept registration prior to the November 7 election according to the time schedule of their population group (21-A §122(6)).

— The Registrar shall publish his/her time and hourly schedules in a newspaper having general circulation in the municipality at least 7 days before it becomes effective. In municipalities of 2,500 or less population, this publication is discretionary rather than compulsory (21-A MRSA §125).

— The hourly schedule for voter registration established by 21-A MRSA §122 may be changed by the municipal officer according to the needs of the municipality (21-A MRSA §122(8)).

ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 7 — Town clerks who are agents of the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries shall forward to the Commissioner the fees collected and the report of all hunting and fishing licenses issued between October 16 and October 31. (09-137 CMR, Chapter 21)

NOVEMBER 11 — Veteran's Day A legal holiday (4 MRSA §1051).

ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 15 — Monthly/Quarterly expenditure statement and claim for General Assistance reimbursement to be sent to Department of Human Services, General Assistance Unit, 11 State House Station, Augusta, ME 04333 (22 MRSA §4911).

ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 24 — Town clerks who are agents of the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries shall forward to the Commissioner the fees collected and the report of all hunting and fishing licenses issued between November 1 and November 15. (09-137 CMR, Chapter 21)

NOVEMBER 23 — Thanksgiving Day, a legal holiday (4 MRSA §1051; 20-A §4802).
