**IT IS ORDERED** that the Millinocket Town Council grant approval for the closure of the following streets and parking lots for the Trails End Festival:

1. Veterans Memorial parking lot from 7 a.m. on Friday, September 13<sup>th</sup>, until midnight on Saturday, September 14<sup>th</sup>.
2. Poplar Street from Penobscot to Katahdin Avenue from noon on Friday, September 13<sup>th</sup>, until midnight on Saturday, September 14<sup>th</sup>.
3. Congress Street from Birch Street to Granite Street on Sunday, September 15<sup>th</sup>, from 7 a.m. until 4 p.m. (only allow local residents access to and from their homes).
4. Inside outgoing travel lane on Central Street bridge on Sunday, September 15<sup>th</sup>, from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m., for the rubber duck race.

**NOTE:** A police officer will lead the parade from Stearns High School across Second Street to Penobscot Avenue and down to the Bandstand at 10 a.m. on Saturday, September 14<sup>th</sup>. The parade will follow the 5k run that will take place on Saturday, September 14<sup>th</sup> at 8 a.m.

**Street closures and items for Trails End Festival (Sept. 13<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>)**

**Friday, Sept. 13<sup>th</sup>: Close Parking Lot at Bandstand from 7AM and keep closed till Midnight on Saturday, Sept. 14<sup>th</sup>**

**Close Poplar St from Penobscot to Katahdin Ave from Noon on Friday, Sept. 13<sup>th</sup> till Midnight on Saturday, Sept. 14<sup>th</sup>.**

**Have Police Officer to lead parade from Stearns High School across Second St to Penobscot Ave and down to Bandstand at 10AM on Saturday, Sept. 14<sup>th</sup>. This will follow the 5K run that will take place at 8AM on Saturday.**

**Sunday, Sept. 15<sup>th</sup>**

**Close Congress St from Birch St to Granite St from 7AM till 4PM. Only allow local residence access to and from their homes. This will help with safety concerns during the events.**

**Close inside outgoing travel lane on Central St. bridge from 9AM-11AM for the rubber duck race to address safety concerns with the crowd.**
