Recently, I have received a request from Bill Frost and Hilary Gallione of 430 Katahdin Ave., to abate excessive wastewater fees. The amount requested is on the abatement form itself. This request is due to a broken water pipe after the water meter, which has since been repaired. The water released from this leak went to the sump pump and out the back of the house, not into the sewer system. After talking to the home owner, the town manager and myself made the determination that this was not due to negligence. Because of the time frame in which this took place, I am requesting this abatement in spite of the Council's decision to eliminate the abatement process all together on April 1st.
