The Town of Millinocket has an immediate opening for a highly motivated, community oriented full-time Police Officer. To be considered for this outstanding opportunity, applicants shall be at least 21 years of age and have a valid Maine driver's license. Candidates that are not full-time certified must have passed the Maine Criminal Justice Academy ALERT Test and have recently passed (within the last year) the Maine Criminal Justice Academy's physical agility test and have the ability to perform the essential job functions of a Law Enforcement Officer. An Associate's Degree in Criminal Justice or related field, or a combination of relevant training and experience is desirable. Preference will be given to graduates of the Basic Law Enforcement Training Program (BLETP).

Candidates must have no criminal or adverse traffic record and may undergo an oral interview, background investigation, polygraph, psychological testing, and a medical exam.

Millinocket is a very special place with plenty of recreational opportunities. The area has many hiking, snowmobile and ATV trails all at the edge of Maine's vast forest. It is the gateway to Mount Katahdin, voted World's Best Hike by National Geographic and home to the northern terminus of the Appalachian Trail. The Millinocket Police Department is a small Community Oriented police department that provides 24 hour coverage, 7 days a week. The town of Millinocket has a population of 4500 (estimate) people.
