The Land and Water Grant: We did not receive this grant, the committee felt that it was deferred maintenance and that it did not qualify for a Land and Water Conversation Grant. This grant was for \$42,000 and Millinocket was going to matched the \$42,000 with a total of \$84,000. This grant was going to replace the dugouts, 10 Ft. fencing for the baselines and infield work on the Delahanty Field. The Girls softball field was going to get a new fence and infield work done. The Play Ground was going to get new timbers and surface .

Gloria C. Mackenzie Foundation Grant: We have applied for the Gloria C. Mackenzie Foundation Grant for \$79,000 to get the work done that needs to be done on all three fields..

Review Budget: We have not met with John on the budget yet. There is some work that needs to be done at the Pool. We want to replace two windows that look out over the pool, they crank out over the deck and we feel that they could be a safety issue. The price will be around \$800.00 to replace. We also need to Change three check vales in the pit, drain the pool and acid wash it due to some staining. The total cost will be around \$8,047.00.

Summer Employment: We are still looking for more employees for the summer season. We are going to call the employees from last year to see if they're coming back to work for us. We also have put applications in both high schools.

Winter fest: The activities for winter fest went well.
