Youth entering grades 9 – 12 will be able to Participate in the summer High School Basketball program in both East Millinocket and Millinocket.



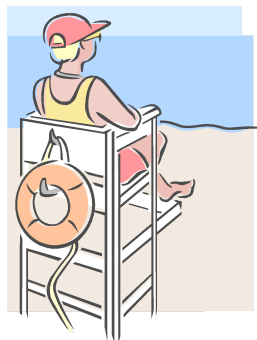
