History of Age-Friendly Millinocket

- Thrive Penobscot started the age-friendly work through the Thriving in Place (TiP) initiative
- April 2019 Town applied to become a member of the network of Age-Friendly States and Communities and was accepted into the program- a National Program
 - O Cody McEwen was the chair of the committee at that time
 - O Jane became chair after being elected to the Town Council in 2020
- 2020/COVID-19
 - O Committee meetings suspended
- 2020-2021
 - O Kept things going but no consistent committee meetings
 - Did help the town apply for the DOT PPI Grant which is a bicycle and pedestrian study grant- to make Central Street and Penobscot Ave (downtown) more walkable

- Planned and held the Katahdin Snowdown as a result of the AARP Challenge Grant award of \$5000.
- Sand Buckets for Seniors Program was launched in collaboration with the Fire Dept and Public Works
- Worked on Vision & Mission Statement for Action Plan (used the Katahdin Gazetteer as a reference)
- Town received a reprieve for submitting our Action Plan knowing we were going to have a Lifelong Maine AmeriCorps member working with us starting in the fall that could assist us to complete it.
 - > Was originally due in April of 2021
 - Sarah Jandreau will be concentrating on completing our Age-Friendly Action Plan by April 2022, along with other projects

Welcome Sarah Jandreau

- Lifelong Maine AmeriCorps Program (LMAP) Project Organizer serving Age-Friendly Millinocket
- Working on the Age-Friendly Action Plan draft that she received from Jane
- Open to new ideas to make Millinocket more Age-Friendly and multi-generational
- Recruitment for Age-Friendly Committee
- Deploy Wilder Collaborative Survey to current committee members
 - A baseline of collaboration in Millinocket before AmeriCorps/Age-Friendly Millinocket is needed

Age-Friendly Action Plan and other projects

- Jane shared the current draft of our action plan that had been started last year
- Vision/Mission statement taken from the Katahdin Gazetteer
- Framework is the 8 Domains of Livability
- Discussion on Community Gardens Project
 - O What model do we want?
 - O Where will the garden or gardens be located?
 - O Who will benefit?
- Want to make this plan realistic and not overdo it
- Will include what is working now and what we want to continue
 - O Sarah will share draft action plan for feedback

Community Needs Assessment

• Working with David Wihry from the University of Maine Center on Aging in collaboration with the Youth Committee on a survey of what we want to see in a community/youth center

- It will provide more data for our action plan
- Jane will share the draft with the committee to review once newest draft version is ready
- Jane clarified that current action planning is based on original assessment done when the Thriving in Place (TiP) initiative started in 2016. Needs have not changed significantly.

- Diana shared that a second Age-Friendly AmeriCorps member will be starting in a couple of weeks
- Katahdin Snowdown plans are being finalized for Feb 20th- a separate committee is working on this
- Sand Buckets for Seniors Program
 - O Would like to reword flier

 - O Jane plans to discuss flier with Tom
