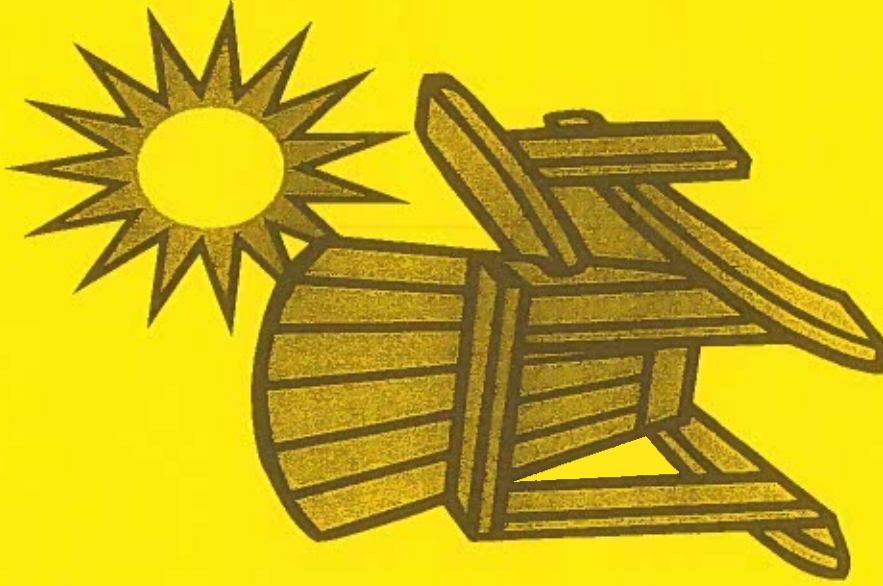

Swimming lessons will begin June 27<sup>th</sup> and end on August 5<sup>th</sup>. A fee is charged for swimming lessons as follows:

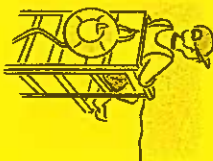
One Child - \$15.00
