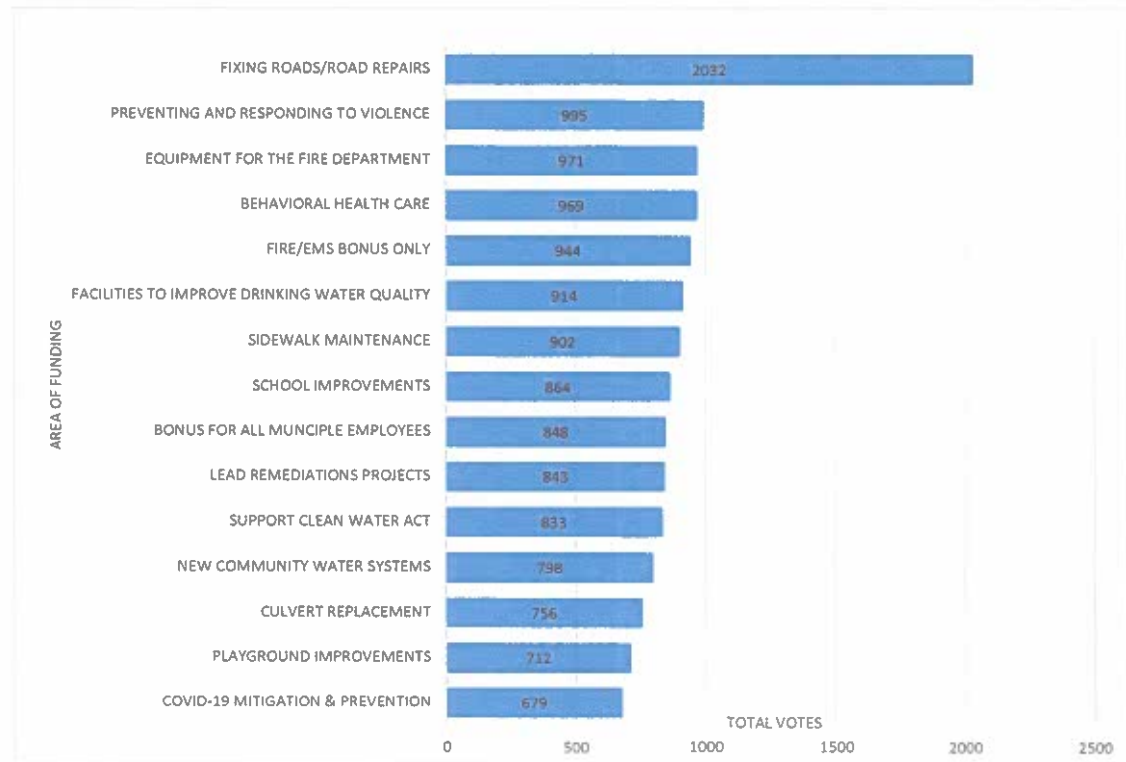


Town of Millinocket ARPA Survey Results

The Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF), a part of the American Rescue Plan, delivers \$350 billion to state, local, and Tribal governments across the country to support their response to and recovery from the COVID-19 public health emergency.

Throughout the month of June the Town of Millinocket collected 264 surveys, 195 in person and an additional 69 online, from its citizens. Citizens were asked to rate each category one (least important) through five (most important), the totals are based on those votes. See the results below, the top five are highlighted off to the side. The charts displays all category votes in comparison with the eachother.
