Old Business: Opened with discussion on completed revised Rules & Regulations for the Millinocket Cemetery. No discussion. Bob motioned for a vote of approval and to forward to Town Council for approval. Seconded by Leola. All present approved the motion. Bryan will forward to the Town Council.
