

Town of Millinocket Request for Proposals: Electrical Work at Katahdin Pride Park

Introduction:

The Town of Millinocket is seeking proposals from qualified electrical contractors to perform electrical work at Katahdin Pride Park, specifically in the Sliding Hill area. The scope of work includes connecting electrical services to a new rope tow that will be installed for winter months.

Scope of Work:

- Provide electrical connections from existing service to the new rope tow base unit.
- Install 240V split-phase electrical service at 50 amps, underground.
- Ensure all electrical work meets relevant safety standards and codes.
- Provide necessary permits and inspections.
- Provide length of run from existing service to base unit location.

Requirements:

- Insurance: Contractors must provide proof of liability insurance and workers' compensation insurance
- Bid Package: Please submit the following in your bid package:
 - Proposal detailing scope of work, timeline, and cost
 - W9 form
 - Proof of insurance
 - Any relevant certifications or licenses
- Workers' Compensation: Contractors must provide proof of workers' compensation insurance.
- Mandatory pre-bid meeting on Tuesday, June 25th at 10am.
