### Seasonal Lawn Mowing and Grounds Maintenance

Reports to: Public Works Director, or Leadman in absence of Director

#### Summary:

This position is a semi-skilled position involving the operation and daily maintenance of lawn tractors, zero turn lawn mowers, gas powered string trimmers and other hand and power tools that the work necessitates. This position is a part time seasonal position. This position will be 24-32 hours per week as needed at the discretion of the Public Works Director.

#### Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Follow safe and effective operation procedures for any and all Town equipment being used
- Mowing and trimming roadsides, Town Parks, ditches and other grassy areas
- Trimming brush along Town sidewalks, paths, trails or roads
- Raking, shoveling and sweeping of dirt, loam and debris as needed
- Collecting and disposing of roadside trash and debris
- Daily fueling and maintenance of assigned equipment
- Communicate with Public Works Director or Leadman for any concerns or questions of job assignments
- Follow all Town Rules and Regulations as posted for Public Works Employees
